

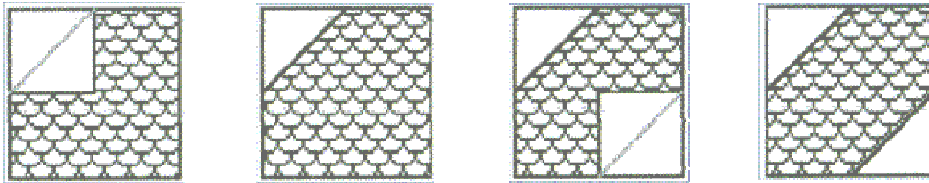
“STRETCHED STARS”

A scrap quilt made from old-fashioned medium to dark calico squares in small to medium scale prints.

The star points are a light tone-on-tone fabric in off-white, antique white, ivory (no tans).

(Please pre-wash all fabrics)

- ☺ Cut medium to dark prints into 5" x 5" squares.
- ☺ For each print square, cut two light squares, 2 1/2" x 2 1/2" each.
(they can be the same fabric, or different - as you choose)
- ☺ Mark (press or draw) a diagonal on the wrong side of each small square.
- ☺ Place one 2 1/2" square in one corner of the background square, right sides together.
- ☺ Stitch on the diagonal.
- ☺ Press the print from the seam toward the corner.
- ☺ Cut off the middle layer, leaving a 1/4" seam allowance. Do not cut off the background.
- ☺ Place a second print square in the opposite corner.
- ☺ Repeat from *



Each 5" square will be considered one entry.

The winner will join the completed blocks in rows and then join the rows to make

“ Stretched Stars”
