

AUTUMN FANTASY

Due at October 13th Meeting

We have selected a project to appeal to both the piecers and the appliquers.

It's easy, fun and a great way to use up some of those leftover pieces you've been saving.

LEAF BLOCK - 8½ SQUARE UNFINISHED SIZE

BACKGROUND - PREWASHED UNBLEACHED COTTON MUSLIN. - Cut 8½" square for each leaf

LEAVES - Choose fabric designs with fall leaf colors of GOLD, BURNT ORANGE, CRANBERRY, BRICK RED, RUST, TAN to BROWN, etc.. (please use fabrics with designs - no solids)

LEAF SIZE should be approximately 7", leaving 1¼" inside border on all 4 sides of block. Select leaf pattern from back of this page or any other leaf design that you want to use.

Prepare leaf for YOUR CHOSEN APPLIQUE METHOD. Allow turn under allowance if necessary. Machine or hand applique. No raw edges.

May use fusible technique, dryer sheet applique, freezer paper, needle turned or? If machine appliquing, use threads to blend or contrast.

Zig zag, blind hem or buttonhole stitch work well.

Your machine may have other stitches you can use.

Have fun! This a "comfort quilt," not an heirloom.

16 PATCH BLOCK - 8 ½ SQUARE UNFINISHED SIZE

⊗ Check your scraps for leftover 2½." strips or 2½" squares

- ✿ These blocks will look best with an eclectic mix of fabric patterns. Plaids, paisley, tone-on-tone, geometrics, small calicos, etc..
- ✿ Choose fabric designs with fall leaf colors of GOLD, CRANBERRY, BURNT ORANGE, BRICK RED, RUST, TAN to BROWN, etc. Select many color values. (Please - no solids)

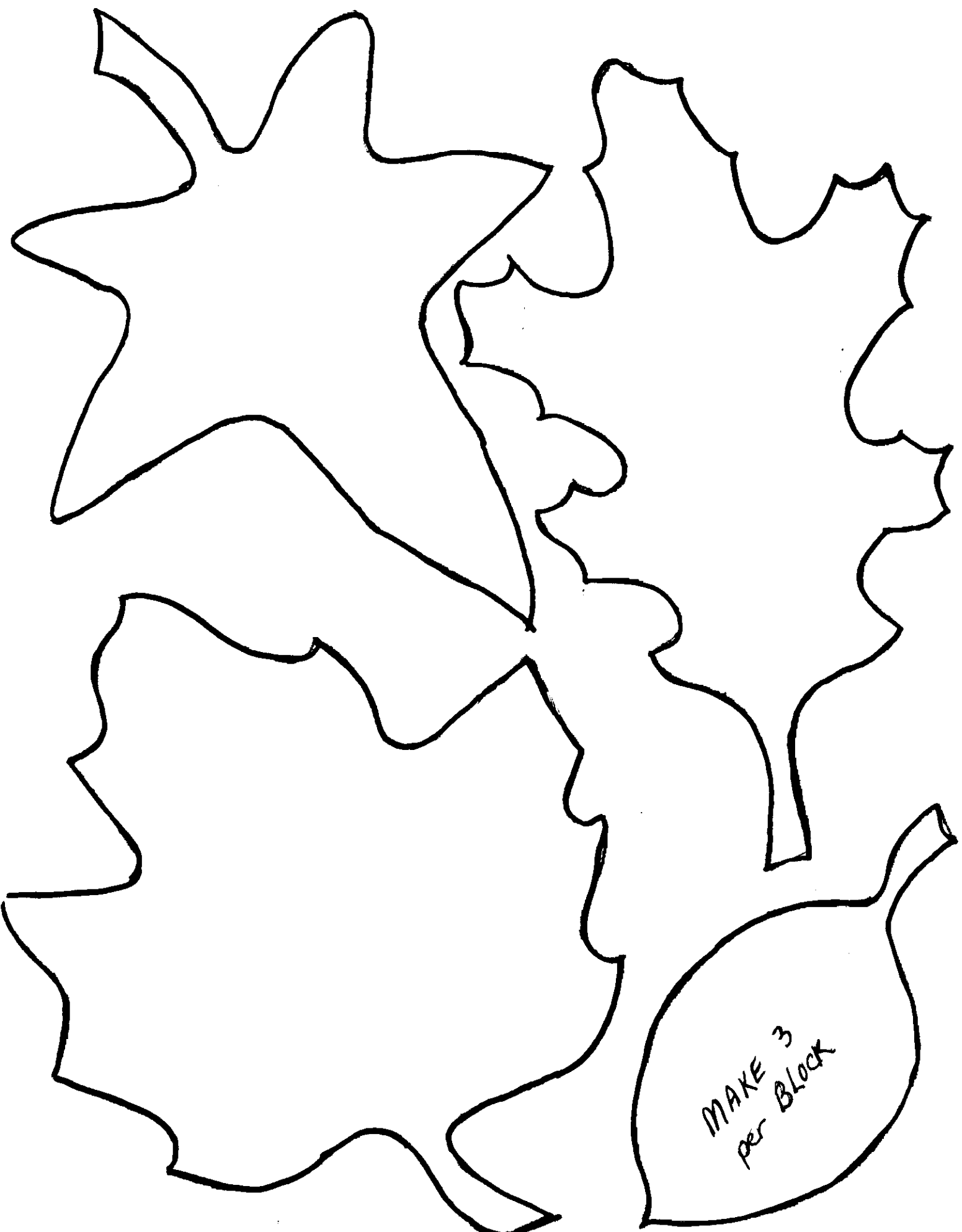
ASSEMBLY

- ✿ Sew 2½" squares in rows of four - **1/4"** seams
- ✿ Sew four rows together to make 8½ unfinished block.

You will receive ONE TICKET FOR THE DRAWING for EACH BLOCK turned in. You may choose either the LEAF BLOCK or the 16 PATCH BLOCK or BOTH
