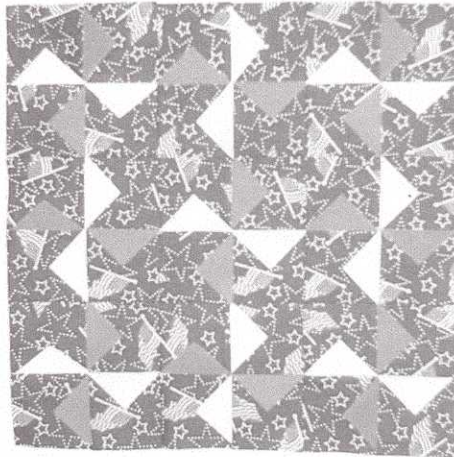


PATRIOTIC PINWHEELS
BLOCK PARTY - DUE JUNE 14, 2004



FABRIC NEEDED:

- Background - 4 - 3½" squares of dark blue patriotic fabric
- Pinwheels - 2 - 3½" squares of wow or white with very small white patriotic print
- 2 - 3½" squares of red or very small red patriotic print

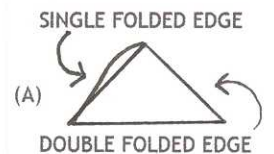
PINWHEELS - FOLDED TRIANGLES:

Fold each of the 3½" squares cut for the pinwheels in half diagonally. Press well. Fold again into smaller triangles. Press accurately and well.

All of the raw edges should be lined up evenly.

The triangles will have one side with a double-folded edge and one side with two single folded edges. (see illustration A)

These edges will be referred to for correct placement on background squares



ASSEMBLING BLOCK:

With right sides together, place one white triangle on the background square with raw edges of triangle aligned with one side of the square. Pin well.

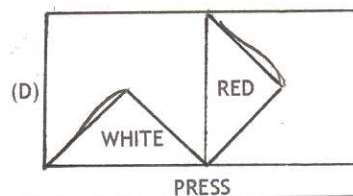
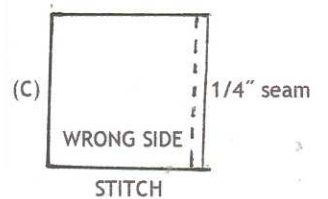
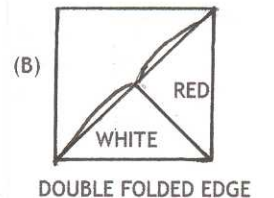
Place a red triangle next to the white triangle matching double-folded edges.

Make sure that the double-folded edges fit tightly together. Pin well. (illus. B)

Place a second background square over the pinned triangles section - right sides together. Stitch along the edge as illustrated (illus. C).

Open up squares and press second triangle toward second square. (illus. D)

You now have one set or ½ of a block.



Repeat the above for the second set.

Place the two sets right sides together aligning four triangle points in the center. Stitch. (illus E)

Press seam on back. To distribute the bulk where the seams come together, twirl seam allowance in one direction to spread open the fabric.

Final pressing is done on the front.

We will have the Display Board showing the construction steps at the Association Meeting.
