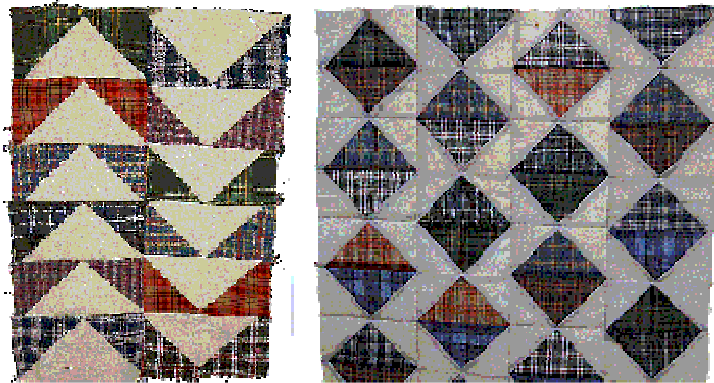


# FAST FLYING GEESE BLOCKS

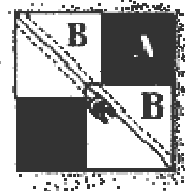


**FABRIC NEEDED:** Fall color plaids (no pastels)-  $5\frac{1}{4}$ " square

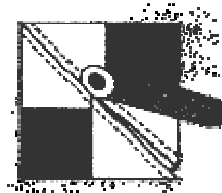
Cream colored tone on tone fabric -  $4 - 2\frac{7}{8}$ " squares

## FLYING GEESE BLOCK CONSTRUCTION:

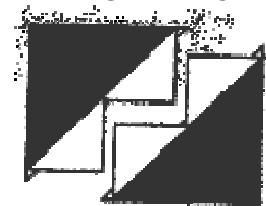
1. With right sides together, place 2 small squares at opposite corners of the large square. Align edges and pin in place. (The corners of the small squares will overlap in the center.)



2. Draw a straight line from corner to corner through the small squares.
3. Stitch an accurate  $\frac{1}{4}$ " away from the line on both sides.
4. Cut the squares in half along the drawn line.



5. On each half, press the small triangles and seam allowance away from the large triangle.
6. Position another small square at the corner of one of the large triangle, pin in place and draw a diagonal line from corner to corner.
7. Again sew a line of stitches  $\frac{1}{4}$ " away from the line along both sides.

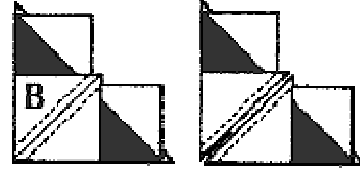


8. Repeat for the second large triangle.
9. Cut apart on the drawn line to create 2 Flying Geese units.

10. Press the small triangles away from the larger triangles.

11. Repeat to make two more Flying Geese units.

You will receive ONE TICKET IN THE DRAWING FOR EACH SET OF FOUR BLOCKS turned in
