

BLOCK PARTY – RAW EDGE APPLIQUE: FLOWER POWER – DUE April 10, 2005

Fabric Needed:

Please use 100% Cotton Quilt-Store-Quality pre-washed fabric. Scraps are great for this block!

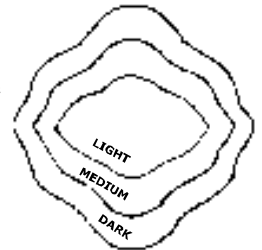
Background: (1) 6 1/2" Square of White-On-White Fabric (no cremes/beiges)
Flowers: (1) 5" Square of a Light, Medium and Dark - your choice of color.
Avoid batiks as they do not fray well.

Construction:

1. Trace flower patterns onto designated value using your preferred method and cut out. Don't forget we're fraying these edges, so don't stress on perfection
2. Fold your 6 1/2" White Square in half and then in half again and finger press to mark the center of the block. Do the same with your large flower. Center the flower in the middle of the white square using the guides and pin.
3. Using a coordinating thread, sew 1/4" inside the large flower.
4. Place the medium flower inside the large flower. Instead of lining it up perfectly, it approximately 45 degrees. Sew 1/4" inside.
5. Place the small flower inside the medium flower; rotate it 45 degrees and sew 1/4" inside.
6. That's all there is to it! If you want to do a split flower as in the sample, simply your White-On-White fabric squares to 7". Complete four different colored blocks and then sew them back together. It's that simple!

Drawing :

You will receive one ticket for each block that you turn in. To save time at the meeting, please put your name on the back of the blocks prior to the meeting.



Place template against folded edge of fabric in order to cut flowers to size:
