Make small felt, fabric and pompom mice to fit into a ½ walnut shell bed. Can be used as a magnet or knick knock. Demonstration

_____ HEXAGON QUILT - Barbara Montejo
If you are looking for an easy hand project to carry around to meetings and waiting rooms - then this 6 inch hexagon block is it! Demonstration

_____ TOOTHBRUSH FABRIC RUG - Corine Cudney
Use new or recycled 2 inch strips to make an oval rug with a toothbrush or a big eyed dull needle. Demonstration

_____ SILK RIBBON AND BRAZILIAN EMBROIDERY - Mania Badmagrian and Slyvia Yoosephiance
Demonstration of silk ribbon and Brazilian thread to embellish quilts, crazy quilts and wearables

_____ FABRIC MAKEOVERS - Leanna Chase
Transform your fabric rejects into the stars of your next quilt by using acrylic art products and/or Shiva paintstiks. Demonstration

____ THE 10-MINUTE 3-D BLOCK - Lorene Robbins
This quick, large block creates a 3-D Bow Tie or a 3-D Cathedral
Window inset in record time. A crib quilt can be done in 1 hour!
Bring sewing supplies and 5 8inch squares to make a sample.

____ PAPER PIECED FIVE-POINTED STAR - Sandy Jewett
Learn how to make a 6" block of a five-pointed star. A pattern
will be provided with cutting templates to help conserve fabric in
this messy technique I love to hate. Demonstration

____ VETERANS QUILTS SEW-IN - Karen Van Den Brink
This will be ongoing all day and may be chosen in place of a
class.
